1. NEW BUSINESS

A. Sepsis – Role of EMS – "sepsis alert"? AMR did training for crews. Could push fluids. Tests in field? False positives are huge. Fluid resuscitation, good history, maybe larger bore IV fluids. Alert ER to accurate temperature. In history – need recent surgeries, recent episode of upper respiratory infection, age of 60 and above. Comorbidities – diabetes, respiratory and urologic, immune compromised. Good for medics to let ER know ASAP if suspect sepsis. Request for Marc to share "flow sheet" for sepsis. Radio call-ins – longer to give more information. Discuss next month with screening tools from both hospitals. May lead to changes in Life Threats policy. Documents will be shared electronically. Anthony Daddario will work on this.
