## **Accomplishments**

- On 12/13/22 Board of Supervisors approved the purchase of the Bay Federal building at 5300 Soquel Ave. The intention is to provide services for Youth Crisis Stabilization Program and Youth Crisis Residential Program.
- Notified of tentative award from State of CA Behavioral Health Continuum Infrastructure Program
   (BHCIP) Round 4 grant for \$11.79 MM to construct a facility to build a Youth Stabilization Program and
   Youth Crisis Residential Program
- Successfully completed External Quality Review Organization (EQRO) audit in November for DMC-ODS regarding providing on-going CalAIM updates & support for all BH staff (County & contract partners for both Mental Health Plan and DMC-ODS)
