

Fish and Wildlife Advisory Commission Announces \$20,000 in Grant Funding to Benefit Native Species and Habitats

SANTA CRUZ COUNTY – The Santa Cruz County Fish and Wildlife Advisory Commission (FWAC) is seeking Request for Proposals (RFP) for projects that support native species, protect and restore habitats, or advance fish and wildlife education and enforcement. A total of \$20,000 in grant funding is available, and requests of all sizes will be considered.

Timeline:

- Applicants are invited to the FWAC meeting on November 6, 2025 at 6:30 p.m. to briefly present their proposals. Location: Solarium Conference Room. 1060 Emeline Ave., Santa Cruz, CA 95060.
- Final funding decisions will be made at the **December 4, 2025 meeting,** when commissioners will determine whether to fully fund, partially fund, or decline each request.
