Standardized assessment tools, such as the World Health Organization's Alcohol Use Disorders Identification Test (AUDIT) and the Drug Abuse Screening Test (DAST), are used to identify the high-risk behavior and determine the appropriate intervention or treatment needed. Screening services do not include intervention, treatment, or therapeutic intervention, such as medication therapy or a combination of medication and counseling
