<b>ASSESSMENT</b>		
Service	New Code	Description
<b>Alcohol and/or Substance Abuse structured assessment (other than tobacco)</b>	<b>ODF=AG0396S IOT=AIOG0396S</b>	Used when conducting an ASAM assessment including full ASAM (ALOC), ASAM re-assessment and ASAM Brief screening.
<b>Psychiatric Diagnostic Evaluation</b>	<b>ODF=A90791 IOT=AIO90791</b>	Used to document assessment activities completed by LPHA.
<b>Psychiatric Evaluation of Medical Records &amp; Tests for Medical Diagnostic Purposes</b>	<b>ODF=A90885 IOT=AIO90885</b>	Used when a provider is asked to conduct a review of records for diagnostic purposes and when there is <b>no direct patient contact</b> . <b>Example:</b> LPHA is determining Medical Necessity and/ or MD/NP/PA is documenting medical review.
<b>Alcohol and/or Drug Screening</b>	<b>ODF=AH0049 IOT=AIOH0049</b>	Used for patient screening that is performed, annually or biannually, to identify possible high-risk behaviors such as alcohol and substance abuse. Standardized assessment tools, such as the World Health Organization's Alcohol Use Disorders Identification Test (AUDIT) and the Drug Abuse Screening Test (DAST), are used to identify the high-risk behavior and determine the appropriate intervention or treatment needed. Screening services do not include intervention, treatment, or therapeutic intervention, such as medication therapy or a combination of medication and counseling
<b>Alcohol and/ or Drug Assessment code</b>	<b>ODF=AH0001 IOT=AIOH0049</b>	Used when conducting other required assessment activities outside of ASAM assessments including; gathering required historical information, reviewing & signing intake forms/ consents.

<b>CRISIS INTERVENTION</b>		
<b>Service</b>	<b>New Code</b>	<b>Description</b>
<b>Alcohol and/or Drug Services Crisis Intervention</b>	<b>ODF=AH0007 IOT=AIOH0007</b>	Used when meeting with client in crisis (SUD crisis = actual relapse or unforeseen event or circumstance, which presents to the client an imminent relapse threat). Crisis service provided focus on stabilization and alleviating the crisis.

<b>WRAP AROUND &amp; EDUCATIONAL SERVICES</b>		
<b>Service</b>	<b>New Code</b>	<b>Description</b>
<b>Skills Training &amp; Development</b>	<b>ODF=AH2014 IOT=AIOH2014</b>	Use this code to submit claims for Patient Education Services.
<b>Community Based Wrap Around Services</b>	<b>ODF=AH2021 IOT=AIOH2021</b>	Used when coordinating care with providers outside of the DMC-ODS Network including but not limited to PCP, MH provider, Probation & other community resources/ supports. <b>Example:</b> SUD provider within the DMC-ODS Network refers client to a mental health provider *When coordinating care between DMC-ODS Network providers if transferring a client to a different LOC the care coordination code T1017 should be utilized.
<b>Psychoeducational Service</b>	<b>ODF=AH2027 IOT=AIOH2027</b>	Includes providing information regarding mental illness and substance abuse and teaches problem-solving, communication, and coping skills to support recovery and resilience.

<b>PLAN DEVELOPMENT/ DISCHARGE SERVICES</b>		
<b>Service</b>	<b>New Code</b>	<b>Description</b>
<b>Alcohol and/or Substance Abuse services, Treatment Plan development / modification</b>	<b>ODF=AT1007 IOT=AIoT1007</b>	Utilized when <b>updating/reviewing a problem list</b> , developing treatment plans if applicable, developing the discharge plan or discharge summary and reviewing the discharge plan and/ or discharge summary with the client.

<b>INDIVIDUAL COUNSELING</b>		
<b>Service</b>	<b>New Code</b>	<b>Description</b>
<b>Behavioral Health Counseling &amp; Therapy (individual Counseling)</b>	<b>ODF=AH0004 IOT=AIOH0004</b>	Can be utilized with the client as well as with family members or other collaterals if the purpose of the collateral's participation is to focus on the treatment needs of the client and supporting the client achieve their treatment goals.
<b>Alcohol and/or Substance Abuse services, family / couple counseling (SUD Family / Couple Counseling)</b>	<b>ODF=AT1006 IOT=AIOT1006</b>	Utilize when conducting counseling with client and family or significant other.
<b>Alcohol and/or Drug Services, Brief Intervention (Contingency Management ONLY)</b>	<b>ODF=AH0050 IOT=AIOH0050</b>	This code must be used to submit claims for <b>Contingency Management Services</b>

<b>GROUP COUNSELING</b>		
<b>Service</b>	<b>New Code</b>	<b>Description</b>
<b>Alcohol and/or Drug services, group counseling</b>	<b>ODF=AH0005 IOT=AH0005</b>	Group counseling with 2-12 clients.

<b>FAMILY THERAPY / GROUP THERAPY</b>		
<b>Service</b>	<b>New Code</b>	<b>Description</b>
<b>Family Psychotherapy (without Patient Present) 26-50 minutes</b>	<b>ODF=A90846 IOT=AIO90846</b>	Family psychotherapy done when the client <b>is not</b> present.
<b>Family Psychotherapy (with Patient Present) 26-50 minutes</b>	<b>ODF=A90847 IOT=AIO90847</b>	Family psychotherapy done when the client <b>IS</b> present.
<b>Multiple-Family Group Psychotherapy</b>	<b>ODF=A90849 IOT=AIO90849</b>	Family psychotherapy <b>groups that include multiple families.</b>

<b>CARE COORDINATION</b>		
<b>Service</b>	<b>New Code</b>	<b>Description</b>
<b>Targeted Case Management (Care Coordination)</b>	<b>ODF=AT1017 IOT=A10T1017</b>	The code used to document Care Coordination is named “Targeted Case Management” (TCM) in the billing manual. To be utilized when providing care coordination with another DMC-ODS provider.
<b>Medical Team Conference with Interdisciplinary Team of Health Care Professionals Participation by Non- Physician Patient and/or Family Not Present. 30 Minutes or More</b>	<b>ODF=A99368 IOT=AIO99368</b>	To be used for <b>Clinician Consultation</b> when <u>provider is any other type of licensed clinician (non-MD)</u> receiving expert advice from another clinician to inform treatment needs of beneficiary.
<b>Prenatal Care, at risk assessment</b>	<b>ODF=AH1000 IOT=AIOH1000</b>	To be utilized if conducting a perinatal risk assessment of any kind (DHCS has not defined a specific risk assessment to be utilized for this).

<b>RECOVERY SERVICES</b>		
<b>Service</b>	<b>New Code</b>	<b>Description</b>
<b>Comprehensive Community Support services</b>	<b>RSS=AH2015</b>	Helping individuals access needed medical, social, educational and other health-related services.
<b>Psychosocial Rehabilitation (RSS Individual Rehab Counseling)</b>	<b>RSS=AH2017</b>	Providing education to the beneficiary related to mental health, substance abuse, independent living, social, coping and interpersonal skills, relapse prevention within an RSS <b>individual</b> rehab counseling session.
<b>Psychosocial Rehabilitation (RSS Group Rehab Counseling)</b>	<b>RSS= AH2017G</b>	Providing education to the beneficiary related to mental health, substance abuse, independent living, social, coping and interpersonal skills, relapse prevention within an RSS <b>group</b> rehab counseling session.
<b>Alcohol and/or other drug treatment program, Per Hour</b>	<b>RSS=AH2035</b>	To be used to describe additional / other RSS services.
