

# COVID-19 Additional Dose Fact Sheet



## Why?

COVID-19 additional doses are meant to aid those with weakened immune systems who have not responded fully to initial doses.



## Who?

Individuals who completed the Pfizer or Moderna series and are moderately or severely immune compromised.

**Talk to your doctor to see if getting an additional dose is right for you.**

### Conditions and treatments include:

- Active cancer treatment for tumors or cancers of the blood
- Solid organ transplant and are taking medicine to suppress the immune system
- Stem cell transplant within the last 2 years or are taking medicine to suppress the immune system
- Moderate or severe primary immunodeficiency
- Advanced or untreated HIV infection
- Active treatment with drugs that suppress immune response



## When?

28 days after the Pfizer or Moderna two-dose series.
